Example Reasons Outline

I place this class of Russet Potatoes 3214.

In my top pair of 3 & 2, I placed 3 over 2 because plate 3 was more uniform, true to its type and had good consumer appeal. I grant that 2 was uniform but I criticize it for mechanical damage.

In my middle pair of 2 & 1 I placed 2 over 1 because 2 was a more uniform plate. I criticize 1 for not being uniform, mechanical damage and mold which could lead to decay.

In my bottom pair I placed 1 over 4, with 4 the obvious bottom plate. Plate 4 was not uniform, had mechanical damage and missing part of the potato, which leads to decay. This plate was clearly un-edible and a low quality product.
